## RESOLUTION #10 of 2025 Resolution to Adopt a New Village Logo/Seal

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brownville, incorporated in 1828 and located in Jefferson County, New York, recognizes the importance of maintaining a professional and distinctive municipal identity; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing Village seal has served the community for many years, but the Board of Trustees has determined that a modern new design that honors the Village’s history while reflecting its character and future vision; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed the proposed design and finds it to be a suitable and appropriate representation of the Village;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village of Brownville Board of Trustees hereby adopts the modernized Village of Brownville Seal featuring the Brown Mansion, ‘Incorporated 1828,’ and ‘Jefferson County, New York as the official logo and seal of the Village of Brownville; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the newly adopted logo/seal shall be used on all official Village documents, correspondence, signage, and materials moving forward, replacing any previous versions of the Village seal; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to take all necessary steps to implement the use of the new logo/seal and to notify appropriate departments and entities of this change.
